Rain or Shine Event

We are not responsible for the weather leading up to or during the event. The ground could potentially be wet, muddy, and soggy. The wind is out of our control, so extra stakes and weights may be needed. Please plan accordingly.

Event Details

The show is 2 days of outdoor display at The Ledge. Hours are as follows:

- **Exhibitor/Vendor Load-In:** Saturday, September 12 (6:00 a.m. - 8:30 a.m.)
- **Exhibitor/Vendor Load-In:** Sunday, September 13 (7:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m.)
- **Open to the Public:** Saturday (9:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.) and Sunday (10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.)
- **Exhibitor/Vendor Load-Out:** Saturday (2:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.) and Sunday (2:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.)
- One day only is available on Saturday, September 12, 2026.

**Note: The Ledge will assign load-in times to each Exhibitor.*

Exhibitor Applications

- Applications can be submitted online at www.scledge.org.
- If you are unable to complete the online application, we will send you an application via email; once completed, you may send it back. You may also submit your application in person at The Ledge office located at 3581 Highway 70 E, Jackson, TN 38305.
- Applications sent through the mail should be addressed to: The Ledge, PO Box 67, Spring Creek, TN 38378 and should be postmarked no later than September 5, 2026.

Exhibitor/Vendor Acceptance

- Exhibitors must submit at least four (4) images representing work intended for display at the show. Applications will not be considered or accepted without these.
- All work must be original and made personally by the exhibitor. No commission is taken.
- Every applicant will be notified via email regarding acceptance to the show. If you do not have email, you will be notified by phone.
- Once accepted, you may pay the exhibitor's fee either through the link in your acceptance email or by cash or check. The exhibitor's fee is nonrefundable. After the link is sent, you will have until one week before the event (September 5, 2026) to complete the payment. If you are unable to pay via Square, cash and checks may be dropped at The Ledge office located at 3581 Highway 70 E, Jackson, TN 38305, or mailed to The Ledge, PO Box 67, Spring Creek, TN 38378. Mailed checks must be postmarked in time to be received no later than September 5, 2026.
- **Acceptable Categories:** Fine Arts, Jewelry, Honey/Food Items, Painting, Graphic Art, Drawing, Stone, Wood, Fabric, Pottery, Glass, Metal Sculpture. All work must be crafted by the exhibitor. Wholesale or retail items may be accepted only if the collection is thoughtfully curated, aligns with the overall theme of the event or the mission of The Ledge, and meets the quality standards expected of all vendors. All work displayed should keep with the overall family-oriented theme of the show. Handmade or locally sourced items are strongly preferred, but exceptions may be made at the discretion of the organizers.

- **Unacceptable Categories:** No branded items, including sports or corporate logos or representations of commercial entities. No imported merchandise or sales representatives with franchised items (e.g., Paparazzi, Pampered Chef, Tastefully Simple, Thirty-One, LuLaRoe). No manufactured items, balloons, or offensive or violent items. No mass-produced wholesale retail items (buy/resell) that do not support the mission of The Ledge or the overall themes of the event. Exhibitors displaying unacceptable merchandise or merchandise not listed on the approved application will be asked to remove those items. The Ledge reserves the right to reject or remove any work or items deemed unacceptable for this show.

Exhibitor/Vendor Spaces

- The outdoor spaces we provide are 5x5, 10x10, and 10x20 feet. You must bring your own display tables and canopies; electricity is not available outdoors. Since the festival is outdoors, we strongly recommend that canopies be used to protect you and your work from the elements.
- **Canopy weights are required.** All canopies must be secured with adequate weights on every leg. Because the ground may be wet, soft, or hard, stakes alone are not sufficient and may not be relied upon. Vendors are solely responsible for properly securing their own canopies and assume all liability for any damage or injury caused by an unsecured or inadequately weighted canopy. The Ledge reserves the right to require that any canopy it deems unsafe or inadequately secured be taken down, with no refund of the exhibitor's fee.
- Indoor spaces (1st Floor) are available in a range of sizes from 4x4 to 8x10 feet; dimensions (length x width) will vary. Electricity is included with indoor 1st-floor spaces during the event. (The 2nd-floor mezzanine is currently unavailable.) See the Exhibitor contract under the ELECTRICAL section for more information.
- Generators are not permitted.
- There will be no exceptions or changes to your assigned space unless The Ledge management approves.
- Set up is Saturday, September 12 (6:00 a.m. - 8:30 a.m.). Set up on Sunday is 7:00 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. The Ledge will assign a time to each Exhibitor.
- Please check in with The Ledge staff at the Highway 70 entrance. Please do not load in from Highway 152 on either day. If you are not checked in and set up before 8:30 a.m. on Saturday or 9:30 a.m. on Sunday, you may not be able to exhibit. No refunds will be given.
- All participants are responsible for their own merchandise. The Ledge will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. We respect your privacy and will never sell or trade your name, mailing address, or email address.

The Ledge reserves the right to deny any Exhibitor that does not comply with the above rules and regulations of the show.
